Recommendation:

Staff respectfully requests Council appoint two Planning Commissioners for four-year terms, set to expire January 31, 2028.

Staff respectfully requests Council appoint three members to the Library Tax Advisory Committee for four-year terms, set to expire January 31, 2028.

Background & Summary:

The terms of two of the seven Planning Commissioners are set to expire on January 31, 2024. City staff has advertised for the positions and has received two applications, both from the Commissioners whose terms are expiring. In addition to the expirations, one Commissioner has resigned as he has moved outside of City limits. The appointment of the two Commissioners will leave one vacancy, which staff will continue to advertise.

The Library Tax Advisory Committee has three positions that are set to expire on January 31, 2024. Staff has advertised for the positions and has received three applications, all from the members whose terms are expiring.

The work of the Planning Commission involves listening and respecting numerous opinions, developing rules with the other members through compromise, and addressing difficult, sometimes unfavorable topics like homelessness, large commercial development, and environmental impacts. It is important that Planning Commissioners are objective and open to new ideas.

The Planning Commission works with the state Subdivision Map regulations, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and General Plan regulations to review development proposals and create city rules. Candidates should familiarize themselves with these three state rules to better understand the work of Planning Commission.
