



The City of Mt. Shasta invites applications for the position of Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator

The City of Mt. Shasta is accepting applications for the position of Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator. This is a full-time position with a salary range of \$3,195 to \$3,514 per month, depending on experience. Benefits include a generous City contribution to a Cafeteria Plan with family medical coverage that includes a City funded health savings account, vision and dental, and supplemental insurance. The position receives P.E.R.S. 2% at 62 (new members) or 2% at 55 (classic members) retirement plan, 12 holidays per year (96 hours), sick leave (8 hours/month), and vacation days, which accrue monthly at a rate that increases with tenure (80 to 160 hours). The City also has several employee-funded deferred compensation plans available.

The facility sits in a forested area above the beautiful Sacramento River, south east of Box Canyon Dam and Lake Siskiyou and just outside the city limits of Mt. Shasta. Surrounded by views of the Eddies Mountains and majestic Mount Shasta, the wastewater treatment plant is home to blue herons, Canada geese, ducks and an occasional a pair of swans. Such environs will provide for a unique worksite and working conditions for the successful candidate.

As a Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator for the City of Mt Shasta, this position is under the close supervision of the Lead Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator and is responsible for assisting with a variety of activities at wastewater treatment facilities involved in maintaining safe and proper wastewater quality. This position will take part in snow removal and other public works activities including water distribution, wastewater collection, and wastewater treatment system repairs and maintenance as needed. Working in inclement weather and working a flexible schedule will be required, including emergency stand-by duty. This position will also be required to operate a variety of heavy and light equipment, be detail-oriented, and have an understanding of the operations of a wastewater treatment plant.

The ideal candidate must possess a valid Class B California Driver's License, or have the ability to obtain one within one year, and a California Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Grade I Certification. The candidate will also have the ability to follow oral and written instruction, and work cooperatively with others. This individual must be available to occasionally work nights, weekends, and holidays, especially during snow removal activities.

Applications and resumes must be submitted to City Hall, Attn: Human Resources Specialist. The position is open until filled with the first review anticipated to be March 18, 2016. Resumes will not be accepted without a completed application. The final candidate must successfully pass a pre-employment background, physical and drug screen.
