





# Regional Population Comparison 2000 - 2010




# Siskiyou County Distribution by Age




# Regional Median Age Comparison




# Educational Attainment Comparison 25+




# Regional Median Household Income Comparison 2010





# Regional Poverty Rate Comparison 2010











# Local Trends/Summary

- **Siskiyou county has low population growth and an aging workforce.**
- **Large 45-64 cohort of population will increase health services demand for next 20 years. Health Services is projected to have the largest growth in Siskiyou industry from 2008-2018.**
- **Since 2008, 8 of the 12 major industry sectors have lost jobs.**

# Local Trends/Summary

- **Local unemployment rates follow statewide trends even though current month (18.8%) is 7.4% above the State.**
- **Industry employment distribution is more diversified compared to Del Norte and Modoc counties.**
- **There were over 250 more workers commuting into Siskiyou for work than commuting out.**
