You are receiving this letter because your property is located in or on the perimeter of the newly formed Smoke-Free District.

Dear Property Owner:

The Mt. Shasta Municipal Code Chapter 6.20.070 allows for the formation of special smoking related districts. The smoking or smoke-free districts are created and amended by the City of Mt. Shasta Planning Commission and City Council. Any member of the public can petition the Planning Commission to consider districts.

The City Council on April 24, 2017 approved the attached Smoke-Free District. The district encompasses the main downtown area. The district prohibits smoking of any kind on streets and sidewalks throughout the downtown area.

Smoking of tobacco products is allowed in the alleyways not within 20 feet of the sidewalks. Cannabis smoking is still prohibited in the alleyways of the district. Individuals are free to engage in all types of smoking listed in Chapter 6.20 on private property.

The district will take effect May 24, 2017. A copy of the approved district can be found on the Planning Department webpage and at City Hall. Violations of the district rules can result in a citation from the City of Mt. Shasta Police Department as per Mt. Shasta Municipal Code 6.20.090.

Mt. Shasta Smoke-Free District

The City of Mt. Shasta Smoke-Free District includes all public areas, including streets and sidewalks. The border of the district includes both sides of the sidewalk. Alleyways, not within 20 feet of the sidewalks, are open to tobacco smoking.
