Dos and Don'ts of Trash: Effective 7/1/2020

Before Carts are Delivered:

- Paint or stencil your address onto each of your cans **including apartment/unit number
- Full cans must weight 50 lbs or less for safe collection by our drivers
- Bag all garbage - Place closed plastic bags of garbage in your can; don't throw in small, loose items. Bagging garbage prevents odors and reduces windblown litter upon collection
- Put your can out by 7 a.m. the morning of your pick up day
- Tags will no longer be sold at City Hall. Please call us at least one day prior to your pick up day if you will have extra garbage/ cardboard

After Carts are Delivered:

- The lid must close for collection. Overloaded carts will receive an "oops" tag and require additional payment
- Continue to bag all trash before it goes into your cart
- Roll your cart to the curb by 7 a.m. the morning of your pick up day
- If your cart requires service/repair, please call
- If for any reason your trash is not dumped, please call

Please Keep These Items Out of Your Trash:

Bricks, dead animals, hazardous waste (paint, anti-freeze, etc.), car batteries, bulky appliances, construction debris, dirt, flammable or combustible liquids or gasses, hot ashes or coals, rocks, tires, TVs and electronics
