



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mt. Shasta City Council will hold a public hearing during their regular meeting to be held September 28, 2015, at 5:30 p.m. in the Mt Shasta Community Center, 629 Alder Street, Mt. Shasta, California.

Analysis of Brownfields Clean-up Alternatives-Preliminary Evaluation, Remedial Action Work Plan, California Environmental Quality Act Initial Study for the "New Mill" Section of The Landing.

On August 24, 2015, The City of Mt. Shasta was provided documents as part of the ongoing Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfields Multipurpose Grant BF-00793701-0 which will allow for the conducting of cleanup activities at the City owned "New Mill" section of The Landing.

The Analysis of Brownfields Clean-up Alternatives provides alternatives for the City to clean up the "New Mill", a two acre section in the center of "The Landing" Commerce Park, and reviews project effectiveness, implementation, and cost. The Remedial Action Work Plan is a more technical document which outlines the process and activities that will be conducted on the site to conduct cleanup activities.

The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Initial Study for clean-up activities at the "New Mill" section of the Landing, assures that all clean-up activity environmental impacts have been considered and assured to be minimal.

All three documents are required by the Environmental Protection Agency and the City's Public Involvement Plan contract with the EPA.

The purpose of this review is to provide information and obtain feedback from the Council and Public. The City will be providing information to the public on progress and upcoming activities on the site and collect public comment on the documents.

Those citizens in attendance are encouraged to ask questions and express their viewpoints.
