ANNOUNCEMENT CITY OF MT. SHASTA PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Mt. Shasta, CA. June 20, 2019 –

Downtown Collection System Improvement Project: The City of Mt. Shasta Public Works Department, and its Contractor, Cox and Cox Construction Inc. will be replacing sewer infrastructure in various locations of Mt. Shasta beginning the week of June 24th, 2019.

The \$2.781 Million project is funded by USDA Rural Development and is designed to correct pipeline and manhole deficiencies, replace deteriorated and undersized sewer mains, and prevent future sanitary sewer overflows. The project will include the installation of approximately 6,800 feet of sewer mains and laterals from 4 inch up to 18 inch diameter. Installation of a new sewer main under the UPRR at Alma Street will be completed utilizing a bore and jack method of construction. The project will also replace approximately 26 manholes.

Construction is set to begin the week of June 24th, 2019 with mobilization, project layout, and saw cutting, Excavation is set to begin on Cedar Street at East Jessie the week of July 8th, to avoid the City's Fourth of July event. The anticipated completion date is November 2019.

Streets that will be directly affected by the project are; Cedar Street from East Jessie street to Alma Street, Alma Street from Cedar Street to N. Mt. Shasta Boulevard, and McCloud Avenue from S. Mt. Shasta Boulevard to Jefferson Drive. Other side streets will also be impacted with closures and delays.

Alma Street from Pine Street to N. Mt. Shasta Boulevard may be closed for up to 3 consecutive weeks sometime between the dates of July 8th through August 8th. Either a detour or traffic control will be in place during this time.

With the nature of this type of construction in the City streets, drivers can expect temporary road closures and minor delays as traffic control will be required. Please observe construction signs, detours, and flagmen instructions to prevent injuries and accidents and to ensure the safety of workers.
