



The City of Mt Shasta invites applications for the position of Senior Maintenance Worker

The City of Mt. Shasta is accepting applications for the position of Senior Maintenance Worker. This is a full-time position and compensation is \$20 to \$22 per hour, depending on experience. Benefits include a generous City contribution to a Cafeteria Plan with family medical coverage that includes a City funded health savings account, vision and dental, and supplemental insurance. The position receives P.E.R.S. 2% at 62 (new members) or 2% at 55 (classic members) retirement plan, 12 holidays per year (96 hours), sick leave (8 hours/month), and vacation days, which accrue monthly at a rate that increases with tenure (80 to 160 hours). The City also has several employee-funded deferred compensation plans available.

Under the supervision of the Public Works Supervisor, this position oversees and participates in a variety of activities involved in the installation, maintenance, and repair of City streets and related infrastructure, water, and sewer systems, lines, and equipment; and inspects and performs preventive maintenance, servicing, and mechanical repair of stationary and mobile equipment. This lead position also trains and provides work direction to assigned personnel and reviews work for accuracy, completeness and compliance with established standards. The open position has an emphasis on streets maintenance.

The ideal candidate should have strong leadership skills, an ability to work with a variety of personalities, excellent communication skills, the capacity to organize and prioritize multiple projects and an aptitude for exceptional customer service. The applicant should have at least three years of increasingly responsible maintenance experience including work in the installation, maintenance and repair of water and sewer systems, lines and equipment. This individual must currently hold a Class B driver's license and a Water Distribution Operator Grade D2 certificate or have the ability to obtain both within one year. The candidate must also be available to occasionally work nights, weekends, and holidays, especially during snow removal and emergency stand-by activities.

The position is open until filled with the first review anticipated to be October 19, 2020. Resumes will not be accepted without a completed application. The final candidate must successfully pass a pre-employment background, physical and drug screen.
