Soil Removal Work: May 16 to June 30, 2022

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about upcoming work at the Landing Old and New Mill Site (Site) located 1611 South Mt. Shasta Boulevard in Mt. Shasta, California 96067.

What is the work?

- Removal of petroleum, semi-volatile organics, polychlorinated biphenyl, and dioxin contaminated soil
- Sampling to see if workers removed all the polluted soil

When will you see work?

- Expected dates: May 16 to June 30, 2022, Monday – Friday, 6:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Will workers prevent dust?

- Workers will wet down all work areas and securely tarp the loads of all trucks
- Workers will stop work if wind gusts up to 15 miles per hour
- Workers will brush off and, if necessary, wash off all loaded trucks before the trucks drive off-site

What will you see?

- Site access will be controlled for safety
- Approximately 500 cubic yards of contaminated soil will be transported to a State-licensed disposal facility and up to 30 trucks will leave the Site each day
- Workers will use heavy equipment to dig out soil and load it into trucks
- A water truck will spray the work areas

How will the work impact you?

- All streets will be open as usual
- Traffic around the Site will be heavier than usual
- Traffic route is attached

Who will do the work?

- Contractors for the City of Mt. Shasta, under the oversight of DTSC

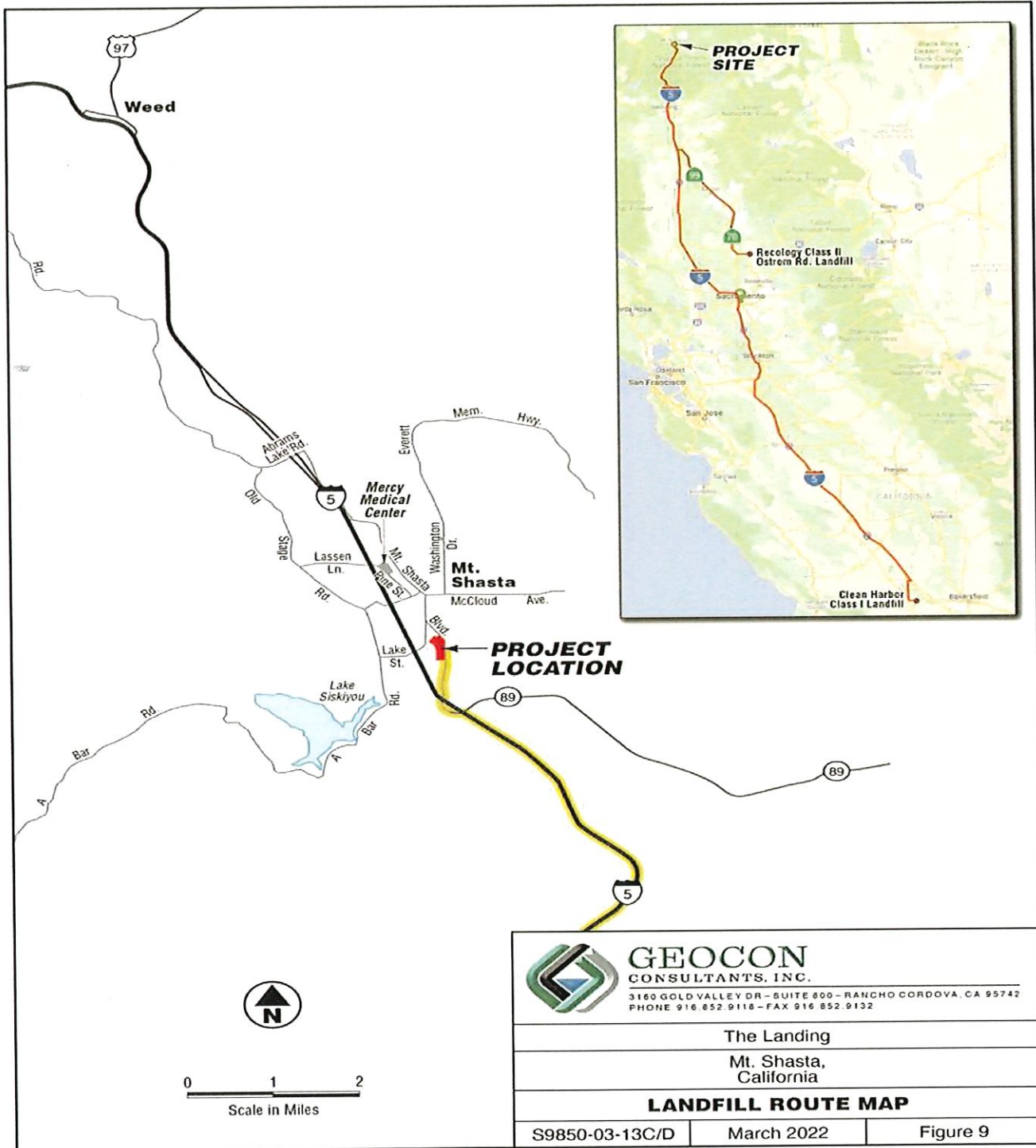
