## ANNOUNCEMENT CITY OF MT. SHASTA PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Mt. Shasta, CA. July 18, 2022 –

**Sewer Interceptor Improvements Project:** The City of Mt. Shasta Public Works Department, and its Contractor, Timberworks has begun replacing portions of the City’s Sewer Main Interceptor line in various locations of Mt. Shasta and Siskiyou County.

The \$5.267 Million project is funded in part through Clean Water State Revolving Fund and is designed to replace the aging 12” sewer main that is over capacity and has experienced failures. The project will include the installation of approximately 7,225 feet of sewer mains, ranging from 12-inch to 24-inch, 480 feet of cured in place pipe lining, 22 manholes, two creek crossings, 48-inch-storm drain replacement. The anticipated completion date is December 5, 2022.

Streets that will be directly affected by the project are West Jessie Street, West Lake Street at Hatchery Lane, South Old Stage Road, and Ream Ave.

With the nature of this type of construction in the City streets, drivers can expect temporary road closures, detours, and delays as traffic control will be required. Please observe construction signs, detours, and flagmen instructions to prevent injuries and accidents and to ensure the safety of workers.

### County Road Impacts:

**Detour #1** South Old Stage Between Ream Avenue and WA Barr Road – This segment will require an approximately 3 weeklong 24-hour road closure to install this very deep section of the sewer main.

**Detour #2:** South Old Stage South of Ream Avenue – This segment will require to be an approximately 1 weeklong 24-hour road closure while the storm drain is replaced. The installation of the sewer main will require 10-hour daily closures (7 AM – 5 PM) for approximately 4 weeks.
