Subject: Municipal Trash Can Design

Recommended Action:

Give Direction to City Staff on municipal garbage can designs

Recommendation Discussion:

There are two distinct directions that the committee can recommend City Staff explore; cohesive or standout design. Cohesive design would favor trash can designs that blend into the architecture of the City. The current City design theme is alpine. The alpine style promotes the use of natural materials such as wood and stone. The negative aspect of the cohesive design is that the cans may be difficult for visitors to fit and difficult to determine what materials go into which bin.



The second design direction is standout style. The standout style makes the bins highly visible. The visibility is due to the coloration of the bins and the shape. The bins can be architecturally interesting and engaging. The negative aspect of the standout designs is that they could be considered too bold and not aesthetically pleasing.



A combination of the two sytel direction can be done for the Committee’s consideration.

Regardless of design direction, the trash cans will need to be bear proof. Animal proof trash cans will need to be almost completely enclosed. The below bin illustrates a front door hatch design that would be animal proof.
